During the last year, the numbers of students coming to learn English and computer studies, has increased and now there are 807 attending our classes. As the country is developing, tourism is increasing, there is such a need to learn English.

Now 4 more classrooms are in the process of being built to accommodate all the students.

During the government school holidays, in March, April and May, we also have Summer School. These are extra to our normal classes, and are for children who cannot come when they have to go to government school, as they live too far away.



Because of the lack of classrooms at our school and the construction taking place, we were not able to run it from here, and so very kindly, the local government school have allowed us to hold our summer school on their premises.

283 are attending and some of our high school students who are now on holiday, are teaching there, along with other volunteer teachers.

Some of our older students have completed a month's course on Photo Journalism, and all older students learnt about domestic violence.

Two more young women have arrived from Mrauk U, and are being trained to become English teachers. In total we are now training 6 young people.

Waste Management Project

A year ago we did a school project with some of our older students, on the problem of rubbish. They learnt about the effect of so much plastic being used, and how we should dispose of

rubbish etc. They then, as volunteers, collected rubbish and made a short video about it, which all our classes were shown.

I was then lucky enough to meet a man who had started Myanmar Trash Heroes, and who very kindly donated T shirts to our school, and Ngapali Trash Heroes was formed. Our kids now go out for 1 hour every Sunday to collect trash. They are all volunteer students, who want to help keep the environment clean, and educate others, so they can bring about change.
