This monsoon season is worse than usual and is causing a lot of hardship for many families.



This family were on the point of starvation, as the lady's husband is away, and she cannot work as she has a 2 year old child. The neighbours gave them scraps of food, but as they are very poor also, it was not enough. The eldest girl who comes to our school and is very bright, was getting thinner and thinner, so we are now providing their food. If you can imagine how difficult it is for them, when everyday there is torrential rain, their clothes get wet and they cannot dry them. Some children go to the forest to try and find some vegetables to eat and some others try to catch fish in the streams.



A brother and sister whose parents went to China to work, were sent to live with their grandfather. However unfortunately he had a stroke, and was not able to look after them, so he sent them to live with their aunt. She had a family problem so also could not take care of them, and we have been able to find a good home for them, and we pay for their food and to be looked after. They are now happy and settled.

Zar Ni Win had a third operation on her leg, as sadly the first two operations were not successful. She was born with deformed legs and feet, and so the blood doesn't circulate properly and she cannot live a normal life. She finished her final year at high school, and we paid for her to stay in a boarding school, and the government headmaster allowed her to just go to school for her final exams. She has passed, can speak good English, is very clever, but sadly cannot work unless this cannot be sorted out.



She will have another operation in August, and she also has to take medication which costs £165 per month and that is without doctor's fees. However if the operations proves successful, she has a very bright future. Her family are very poor.

We are also helping other families and children in need.
