WIN PA PA who is 10 years old, had her foot and part of her leg amputated, because unfortunately she was born with a deformed foot, and as she grew it became like part of a tree trunk, and it became larger and heavier. She also had her hands operated on, because her fingers were deformed.

We had to send her to Yangon which is city 323 miles from here, as it was not possible to have the operation here.

Now her leg is healing, and she has returned to Lintha, and in 6 months she will be able to have a prosthetic leg and foot fitted. As she grows this will have to be changed from time to time, until she is an adult.

Her parents are very poor, and so she would never have got the chance of living a normal life as possible.



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MIN PHONE SAN who is 3 years old, was born with deformed feet, so



he also went to Yangon to have both legs and feet operated on. The surgeon has only operated on one leg and in 6 months he will return to hospital to have the other leg also operated.

His father is a fisherman, and the family live in a large open shed with other families, which is owned by the fishing boat owner, as they have no home of their own.

We will update you in 6 months time on the childrens' progress.
